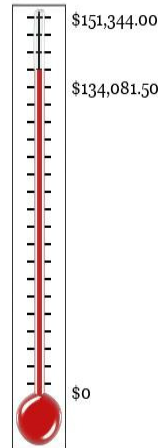

From St. John the Evangelist– Greece

In 1985 St. John – St. Lawrence Men’s Club merged into one group. Each had previously been operating as a separate group in their respective parish. Long-time parishioners may recall St. John’s Men’s Club being known as the Holy Name of Jesus (1900), Holy Name Society (1950-60’s), and St. John’s Men’s Club in the 70’s. Over the years the group has supported the parish annual festivals, pancake breakfasts, Scout Sundays, Veteran’s November Coffee Hour and Parish Pig Roasts for over 40 years and recently the group added Parish Clam Bakes eight years ago. This is in addition to their five dinners and Euchre Tournaments for the men. We have also supported the scouting organizations of our parish with religious emblem contributions and Eagle Scout donations.

In addition to the men of St. John’s and St. Lawrence, attendees have included members of all Greece parishes, St. Leo in Hilton and members of the Cathedral community.

The Men’s Club Executive Committee voted in June 2016 to terminate the Men’s Club June 30, 2017. Our year is July 1 to June 30th as is the church calendar. We had been unsuccessful finding new leadership. Bill Smith chose to try and keep the group operating for another year. Bill Smith is stepping down as of June 1st this year. Our last activities for this year include the Apr 25th Euchre Tournament and the Steak Roast May 23rd.

We would like to thank the many parishioners who have supported our functions over the years and made it possible for us to support the parish in so many ways. We would also like to thank the pastors for the use of the facility over the years. We were very fortunate as we were self-sufficient and never required any parish funds to maintain our many activities.
