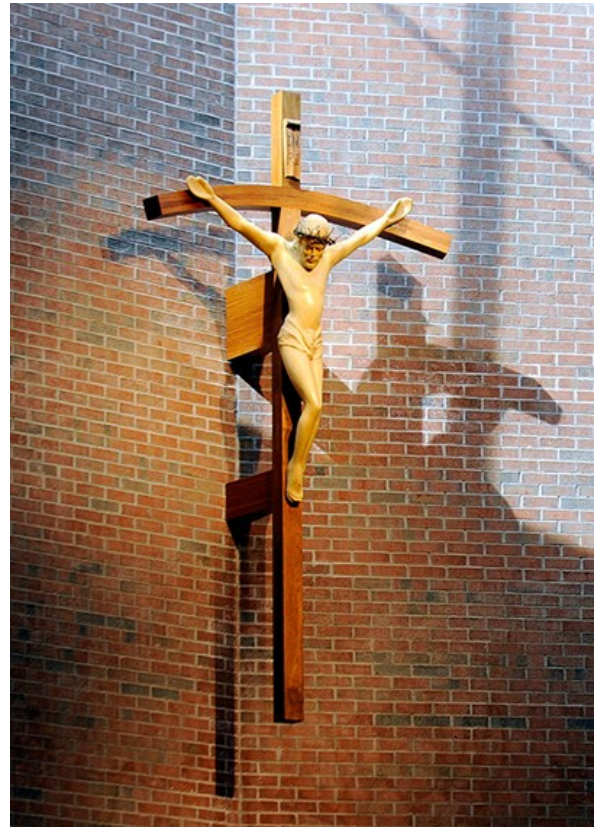

# MUSINGS

We are in the middle of our Lenten Season. I hope and pray that you have taken the opportunity for prayer, for quiet, for fasting, and for giving what you can to the poor and those in need. In order to further us on our Lenten journey, we had the opportunity for the Maryknoll Missionaries to guide us in prayer, to teach us about discipleship and how we can be missionaries. I thank them on your behalf for a wonderful and renewing experience.

To further our Lenten journey, we will join with the rest of the diocese this coming Tuesday for the Annual Day of Penance and Mercy. From 12:30 in the afternoon until 7:30 p.m. confessions will be heard in the Church. Fr. Caton and I will be joined by Fr. Brickler and Fr. Dollen in hearing confessions. We will post a schedule of when and where the individual priests will be. If you haven't been to confession in a while - I will have prepared an examination of conscience for you and in the Church when you come in. Don't worry if you can't remember the exact prayers, formulas or protocols - we'll guide you through that!

To our younger people, our teenagers and young adults, I encourage you to come and experience the joy and grace of reconciliation. Don't let your First Penance be your last penance! Parents, I encourage you to encourage your children to come with you to confession.

And please don't think you'll be embarrassed. We priests are committed in our ministry and priestly vows and promises to keep all that we hear in total confidentiality. We will not reveal to anyone, even in court with threat of imprisonment, what we hear in confession. That Seal of Confession is sacred. And we will not yell, argue, condemn, judge or pick on you. We will not look at you any differently. This is our ministry and our joy to bring to you God's forgiveness and mercy.

Please come!

On a more practical note:

Over the last month, we have been doing some much needed repair, replacement and updating in the rectory. In so doing, as in any time you take up such a project, we have come across some issues - some very serious issues.

In the residence, we have had to replace three broken

windows, a set of broken sliding glass doors, and will need soon to replace the front door. For reasons of security, there was need to replace and not repair. The rectory kitchen appliances were in various states of disrepair if not downright broken and unusable. Further, we found the "remnants" of a rodent infestation. For health reasons, we've taken care of the rodents. And we've replaced the appliances. We've also replaced the kitchen counters which were cracked, burned and broken beyond repair.

Old carpeting, old wall paneling have been removed because of health again (former residents of the rectory were cigarette smokers). New flooring and drywall has been installed. And the furniture which was a bit old, smelly, and in many cases broken has also been replaced.

In the rectory office area, we have discovered some very serious issues of mold, mildew, water damage and rotting wood in the structure. Because of health issues and the fact that we don't want that structure to fall down, we are immediately addressing these issues. Walls have to be replaced, ceilings will need replacement, exterior walls will need to be replaced, gutter and downspouts that have been broken for years will need to be replaced. We are probably looking at the need to replace subflooring, carpeting, etc. And we definitely will need to replace structural wood columns that have rotted.

While we are working with our insurance coverage, this project will involve far more than we anticipated. Anything you can do to offset any of this financial strain will be more than appreciated.

When the weather starts to get a little better, we will begin to address the leaks in the church roof. The sacristy behind the sanctuary will need extensive work. When we get there, I'll inform you of what is happening.

To be good stewards of our property, we need to take care of our buildings - all of them. Painting, carpeting, replacement, fixing is all part of good stewardship. As time goes on, we will establish time lines and forward thinking planning so that these things don't take us by surprise anymore and we're not always re-acting but we pro-act!

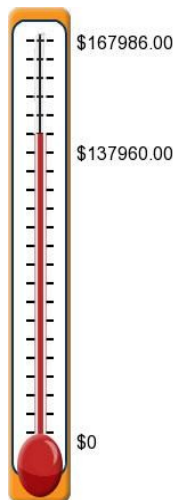

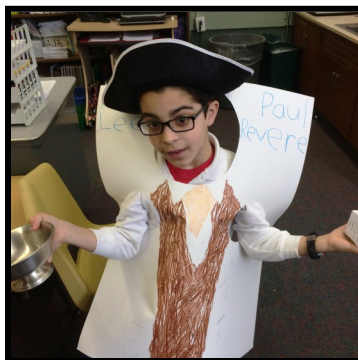

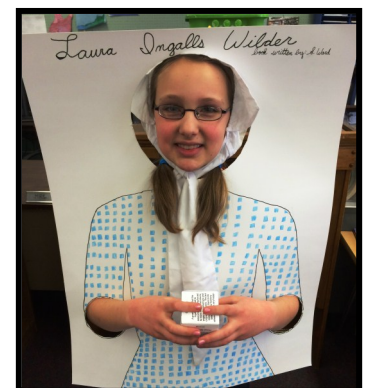
