

Psalm 23 – My Shepherd Is the Lord. (#740)

Refrain:

My shepherd is the Lord, nothing indeed shall I want.

Verses:

- (1) The Lord is my shepherd;
There is nothing I shall want.
Fresh and green are the pastures
where he gives me repose.
Near restful waters he leads me,
to revive my drooping spirit.

- (2) He guides me along the right path;
he is true to his name.
If I should walk
in the valley of darkness
no evil would I fear.
You are there with your crook
and your staff;
with these you give me comfort.

- (3) You have prepared a banquet for me
in the sight of my foes.
My head you have anointed with oil,
my cup is overflowing.

- (4) Surely goodness and kindness
shall follow me
all the days of my life.
In the Lord's own house shall I dwell
for ever and ever.

- (5) To the Father and Son give glory,
give glory to the spirit.
To God who is,
who was, and who will be
for ever and ever.

Psalm 27 – The Lord Is My Light (#746)

Refrain:

The Lord is my light and my salvation.

Verses:

- (1) The Lord is my light and my salvation;
if God is my help, whom should I fear?
The Lord is my refuge,
my stronghold and my strength;
why should I be afraid?

- (2) There is but one thing that I want;
to live in the dwelling place of God;
to look all my days on the beauty of the Lord,
and contemplate God's holy temple.

- (3) I shall see for myself the grace of God,
the dawn of that day among the living.
Wait for the Lord,
find strength in your hearts;
have courage and wait for God.

Psalm 63 – My Soul Thirsts (#769)

Refrain:

My soul thirsts for you, Lord, like the desert thirsts for rain.

Verses:

- (1) I have walked in your temple,
and seen your mighty deeds.
Your love, O Lord, means more to me,
than all my days of life.

- (2) I can count on your mercy
to feed my hungry heart,
for when I lift my hands in need,
a banquet you provide.

- (3) I will make my dwelling
in the shelter of your wings.
Your hand, O Lord, will keep me safe
through darkest night and day.

Psalm 103 – The Lord Is Kind And Merciful (#791)

Refrain:

The Lord is kind and merciful; merciful is the Lord

Verses:

- (1) Bless the Lord, O my soul;
and all my being, bless his holy name.
Bless the Lord, O my soul
forget not all his benefits.

- (2) He pardons all your inequities,
he heals all your ills.
He redeems your life from destruction,
and crowns you with kindness
and compassion.

- (3) The Lord secures justice
and the rights of all the oppressed.
He has made known his ways to Moses,
and his deeds to the children of Israel.

- (4) Merciful and gracious is the Lord,
slow to anger and abounding in kindness.
For as the heavens are high above the earth,
so surpassing is his kindness
toward those who fear him.

Psalm 116 – I Will Walk With The Lord (#795)

Refrain:

I will walk with the Lord in the land, the land of the living.

Verses:

- (1) How shall I make a return
for the goodness God has done for me?
The cup of salvation I will take
and call God's name.

- (2) Precious in the eyes of the Lord
is the dying of his faithful one.
I am the servant of the Lord
who set me free.

- (3) Sacrifice and thanks I will give
in the presence of God's chosen ones.
My vow to the Lord I shall fulfill
and call God's name.

Psalm 122 – Let Us Go Rejoicing (#804)

Refrain:

Let us go rejoicing to the house of the Lord.

Verses:

- (1) How I rejoiced to I hear them say
“Let us go to the house of the Lord.”
And now within your walls
we are standing, O Jerusalem.

- (2) Jerusalem, a city firmly built
knit together in unity and strength.
There the tribes go up,
the tribes of the Lord,
making pilgrimage.

- (3) There the tribes give thanks
to the name of the Lord,
according to the law of Israel.
There are set the thrones of judgment
for the house of David.

- (4) Let us pray for the good of Jerusalem,
and for those who love you
prosperity and peace,
peace within your ramparts and your towers,
peace in your dwellings.

- (5) For the sake of my people and my friends,
I say peace be to you Jerusalem.
For love of God’s house
I pray for you and your prosperity.

Psalm 130 – Out Of The Depths (#807)

Refrain:

Out of the depths, I cry to you, O Lord.

Verses:

- (1) From out of the depths,

O hear the sound of my voice.
Lord, open your ears and listen to me;
I plead for your kindness, O God.

- (2) If you, O Lord, should number our sins,
then Lord, who would survive?
But you are forgiveness for our sins;
for this we adore you, O God.

- (3) I trust in you, Lord, my soul looks to you
as watchmen wait for the dawn.
And more than the watchmen
wait for the dawn,
let Israel wait for the Lord.

- (4) For with you is found kindness of sin;
you show your mercy to all.
and you will deliver your chosen ones;
deliver your people Lord.
